

- + general usage policy of the Global Network applies as well












Additional features available on the Yammer Mobile App




 From the purely semantic perspective, the lack of an indicator dimension makes the meaning of the data a bit less clear - the user needs to know which dataflow the dataset corresponds to to understand what he's looking at.

So while it is not wrong to have no indicator dimension in the DSD and to just have one dataflow per indicator, having an indicator dimension in the DSD can provide for more clarity and flexibility. If you have anyway one dataflow per indicator, you can always attach a constraint to the dataflow to clearly indicate that the dataflow should only be used for one specific indicator
